Artist and Spiritual Teacher Tiziana DellaRovere Releases *Adorata*, A Transformative Exploration of the Sacred Feminine

Decades in the making, *Adorata* is a richly illustrated, full-color work that explores the Sacred Feminine as a living, universal presence expressed through art, poetry, and contemplative practice. Through a series of paintings and written reflections, DellaRovere invites readers into a direct, experiential relationship with the Divine as love.

The title *Adorata*, Italian for “Beloved”, reflects the essence of the work. Rather than presenting a single religious figure, the book reveals the Divine Feminine as a shared human inheritance that transcends culture, tradition, and doctrine.

Featuring 16 Madonnas and corresponding Divine Virtues, *Adorata: The Path of Enlovement* blends sacred imagery with poetic teachings, invocations, and contemplative reflections designed to guide readers into deeper awareness, healing, and inner transformation.

Classically trained in law and philosophy in Italy, DellaRovere later pursued studies in fine arts, clinical psychology, and theology in the United States. She became one of the first women ordained as a priest in the Liberal Catholic Church of Antioch and has since guided thousands through her teachings, private sessions, and sacred art.

“*Adorata* is not about belief,” says DellaRovere. “It is about encounter, about rediscovering love as a living force within us, and allowing that love to transform how we see ourselves and the world.”

Blending visual art with spiritual insight, *Adorata* offers a rare, immersive experience for readers seeking depth, meaning, and a more embodied connection to the sacred.
